Sick Policy

It seems germs have found their way into the Toddler room and a few of our friends have missed school due to illnesses. Just a reminder of what our sick policy is here at Montessori Children's School.

"Children are expected to be in good health when attending school. Please do not send a child who shows any signs of illness. We reserve the right to send home a child who shows definite or continued signs of ill health that may jeopardize the general welfare of the class. We practice the "24 hour rule". If your child is sent home from school

due to vomiting, excessive runny nose, fever of over 100 degrees, or diarrhea, it is necessary for you to keep your child home for a minimum of 24 hours before returning to school. Having a sick or contagious child attend school jeopardizes the health of others and will be avoided at all times."
